- Powerful, dual ring 55,000 BTU burner
- Extra long neck provides extra space between the burner and stand
- Burner has 3/8inch MPT hose fitting
- Cajun Classic Stand 593 is sold separately

This Cajun Classic Cadillac Cooker is a self standing painted cast iron gas burner. The Cajun Classic Cadillac Cooker burner features double ring design, that on low, burns only the inner ring and on high, burns both. The burner measures 24 inches in length and the gas burner head measures 10 inches in diameter with overall head measuring 13. 5 inches in diameter. 55,000 BTU. For use with Propane gas only.

This gas stove has been carefully designed for sound structure and thermal effectiveness. You can use it safely, and it has duplex ring of fire. You can utilized the inner ring in order to adjust the fire strength from low to high.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Turn on master valve (the button on the propane bottle).
- 2. Press the button on the stove with your hand and turn left about 90 degrees.
- 3. When you hear the click and see the fire burn, you can adjust the volume on the valve of your propane bottle.
- 4. When the stove is used, for the first time, you can NOT light it at once. You must allow the air to be pushed out of the tube, to allow the gas to reach the firing point. You may need to turn the button two or three times to reach this point.
- 5. To adjust the air, adjust the regulator. You may need to adjust the regulator additional times until the fire burns properly.
- 6. When you are done, turn the stove knob until you hear a click. That means it is fully shut off.
