Durability — Since Granite is the hardest of dimensional stones, it is very functional and practical. Due to its mineral composition, it cannot be affected by acids such as in juices or rain and is very difficult to scratch or stain.

Maintenance – This top requires only regular wiping with water or occasionally with mild soapy water. Do not use vinegar, cleaners that contain acid, abrasive cleaners, or furniture polish. We suggest the following routine care:

- Blot up spills immediately
- Dust with an untreated cloth
- Use coasters
- Keep planters off the surface
- Keep covered when outdoors and not in use

There are a variety of products available to clean, protect, enhance, and seal through your local marble supplier or in any hardware or building supply store. Use impregnating sealers. For the best long-term maintenance, store the top in a dry location during the off season.
