

Tools Needed For Outdoor Kitchen Island Setup

- Box Knife
- Plastic Shims
- 2-3 Able-Bodied People For Lifting Heavy Objects
- Drill or Screwdriver with Phillips Bit
- 4 ft. Level

Step 1 Unpacking the Outdoor Kitchen Island

Using a box knife cut away the plastic shrink wrap surrounding the Outdoor Kitchen Island, being careful not to cut the Outdoor Kitchen Island or Countertop Sections. Determine which plastic straps are securing the Countertop Sections to the Outdoor Kitchen Island. While one person holds the Countertop Sections for falling, cut the straps securing them against the Outdoor Kitchen Island with the box knife.

Carefully remove the Countertop Sections and set aside. It is advisable to use pieces of the packing foam to set the Countertops Sections on so they do not get scratched or chipped.

Using the box knife cut the plastic bands securing the Outdoor Kitchen Island to the pallet. The Outdoor Kitchen Island is also secured to the pallet with screws. From inside the Outdoor Kitchen Island, remove the screws markets with a green sticker using a Phillips screwdriver, or electric drill with a Phillips bit.

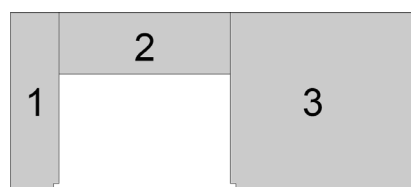
Step 2 Placing the Outdoor Kitchen Island

Determine the flattest and most level location you can for placing the Outdoor Kitchen Island. Remove the Outdoor Kitchen Island from the pallet by lifting both ends at once with two or more people. Carry the Outdoor Kitchen Island to close proximity to your final desired placement and slide into place like you would with a heavy piece of furniture.

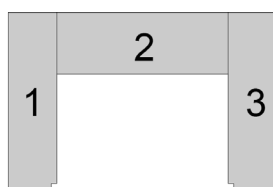
Use a 4ft level to determine where (if any) your Outdoor Kitchen Island needs to be shimmed. From the inside of your Outdoor Kitchen Island, shim appropriately so that it is level and not rocking on two corners. Shimming the Outdoor Kitchen Island from the inside will help prevent the shims from being seen from the outside.

Step 3 Placing The Concrete Countertop Sections

Dry fit the Countertops Sections in place by placing them on top of the Outdoor Kitchen Island in order in which they fit. Each Countertop Section has a numbered sticker that will correspond to a number on top of the Outdoor Kitchen Island. These numbers represent the Countertop Sections placement. 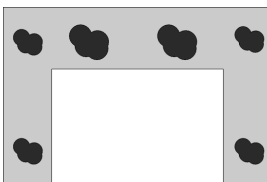
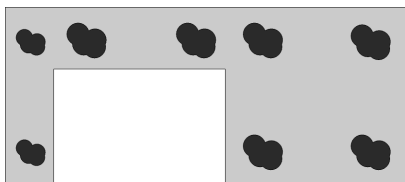


6 Ft. Island

Once it is determined that the Countertop Sections fit properly, remove them for gluing. Using the provided adhesive, place dollops of adhesive on the Outdoor Kitchen Island (according to the diagram below). Re-position the Countertop Sections on the Outdoor Kitchen Island and use shims to make height and level adjustments.



Allow the adhesive sufficient time to set up before placing the appliances. If the Countertop Sections move while placing the appliances, simply nudge them back into place. It is acceptable to place the appliances immediately after securing the Countertop Sections, as long as the Countertop Sections are positioned correctly before the adhesive creates a permanent bond.
