Let the grill cool completely before moving or attempting to transport.





PLACING YOUR GRILL



- When operating this grill under overhead combustibles, a MINIMUM of 40 inches (102 cm) is required.
- When operating this grill, maintain a MINIMUM distance of 18 inches (45.7 cm) from the grill to combustibles.

A Bolt: 5/16"-18 x 3.6" (8 pcs)



B Washer: 5/16" (16 pcs)



C Spring Washer: 5/16" (8 pcs)



D Hex Nut: 5/16"-18 (8 pcs)



STEP 2 (LEG BRACES)

E Bolt: I/4"-20 x 0.6" (8 pcs)





STEP 3 (SIDE SHELF)

F Stainless Steel Screw: I/4"-20 x 0.6" (4 pcs)





G Stainless Steel Washer: 1/4" (4 pcs)



STEP 4 (FRONT SHELF)

F Stainless Steel Screw: I/4"-20 x 0.6" (6 pcs)





G Stainless Steel Washer: 1/4" (6 pcs)



STEP 5 (HANDLE)

H Bolt: I/4"-20 x I.5" (2 pcs)






BEFORE ASSEMBLY: REMOVE GRILL PARTS AND PACKAGING


NOTE: You should assemble grill on a clean, flat surface, as you will need to lay it on its back at times during assembly.




THIS WILL REQUIRE TWO PEOPLE.

NOTE: We recommend you use the packaging material to prop up the grill to make attaching the legs easier.























INSTALL LEG BRACES







INSTALL WI-FI ANTENNA, POWER CORD, AND SIDE SHELF














INSTALL FRONT SHELF



INSTALL HANDLE AND GREASE PAN WITH LINER








ASSEMBLE INTERNAL PARTS




NOTE: Remove all remaining packaging material from grill parts, main grill body, and pellet hopper.
