





ELECTRICAL CONNECTION

 Connect outdoor rated extension cord to Boreal.


LP TANK CONNECTION


1. Locate LP regulator hose.






- Test fan control switch. Fan should be audible with switch in "ON" position.
- 2. Close 20 lb. LP tank valve before connecting to Boreal.







- 3. Test GFCI outlet. Fan should turn off when "TEST" button is pressed. "RESET" button will turn fan back on.
- Hand-tighten regulator hose onto 20 lb. LP tank. Ensure that the nut is centered.

FIXED PIPED GAS CONNECTION

- Locate stainless steel corrugated flex-line. Fittings will be 3/8" female flare for Manual Ignition and 1/2" female flare for DSI.
- Connect flex-line to individual shutoff valve.

LIGHTING INSTRUCTIONS

Manual Ignition

- 1. Ensure control valve is closed.
- 2. Open gas supply valve (either NG valve or 20 lb. LP tank valve)
- 3. Depress sparker button and hold.
- 4. Open control valve.
- 5. Close control valve to extinguish.





Tighten the fittings using two (2) wrenches. Failure to do so may result in fire.

Direct Spark Ignition

- Open gas supply valve (either NG valve or 20 lb. LP tank valve.
- 2. Turn control switch to "ON" position.
- 3. Turn control switch to "OFF" position to extinguish.
